 - The Federal Impact Aid Program attempts to compensate local school districts for their loss in tax revenue due to a federal presence in their district boundaries. In order to receive funding from this program, FCPS conducts a student-parent survey and provides summary survey information to the federal government. All individual information is strictly confidential.
 - Students are to return completed forms to their first period class by Friday, November 11. It is essential that every student return a completed form and that the form is signed by a parent or guardian.**
