- The American Mathematics Contest 8 for students seventh and eighth grade and students that have qualified from the AMC 6 will be administered after school on Tuesday, November 15<sup>th</sup> in the cafeteria.***
  - The AMC 8 is a 25 question, 40 minute, multiple choice examination in middle school mathematics designed to promote the development and enhancement of problem solving skills.
  - There are 50 seats available for students who are interested in participating. Please pick up a registration materials/permission forms from Ms. Galus at TTS or your math teacher.
  - Since Tuesday is not a late bus day, students will need to provide their own transportation home that day or walk.
